Once its broken down, your eye doctor will suction the pieces out of your eye. However, the final cost of your procedure can vary significantly, depending on

several factors, and there may be some costs you will need to cover out of pocket. If that happens, you would have to discuss your treatment options with your doctor. The next visible part of the eye from front to back is the iris, which is the colored part of the eye. Your doctor will use eye drops or a shot to numb your eye. These incisions aren't as small as biaxial, but they're small enough that surgeons feel there are benefits to using them. Have you considered <u>lens replacement surgery</u> to correct your vision?

The incision is self-sealing, so stitches are not needed. It is not intended to replace the discussion between you and your doctor but may act as a starting point for discussion. Although the posterior chamber is the preferred location of the IOL, modern anterior chamber IOL designs have improved a great deal.
